




ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

Education and employment services are offered at no cost to participants and customized to meet individual needs. Through basic skills development and employment services, participants are moving towards self-sufficiency through increased career opportunities and access to higher education.

Youth-Centered, Flexible, and Supportive

With one-on-one support, resources, and tools our youth and young adult programs help young people ages 16 to 24 turn their lives around and take the critical steps toward a self-sufficient future. Through MSC's partnership with Federal Way Public Schools, we support teens and young adults build life skills and achieve their GED or high school diploma. We offer GED preparation and one-on-one coaching to young adults ages 16 to 21 enrolled at Federal Way Open Doors. MSC has dedicated staff who work with students to achieve their academic and personal goals, provide individualized learning plans and other supports, provide comprehensive case management, connection to community resources, post-secondary planning, and positive youth development opportunities.

Employment

Our employment programs serve individuals of all ages and from all walks of life, providing a variety of services including job-readiness training, job search assistance, and career planning. MSC works with candidates at all stages of job readiness. Eligible candidates must be receiving SNAP benefits and meet the following criteria: 16 years of or older; live in South King County; and, willing to work with MSC staff to meet their goals
