## Housing Assistance and Eviction Prevention

Stable housing is a cornerstone for building selfsufficiency for years to come. If you need a place to live, MSC staff will do what they can to help you.



MSC's family shelter consists of 15 two, three, and five bedroom houses in a neighborhood in Kent. Families stay temporarily while working with a case manager to set goals for finding stable housing. To access emergency family shelter in King County, please call the family emergency shelter access line every day you are in need of emergency shelter. Please call 206.245.1026 daily.

# Regional Access Point for Coordinated Entry for All

Embedded within King County's Coordinated Entry for All (CEA) program, MSC acts as one of five Regional Access Points (RAP) locations where families currently experiencing homelessness may seek resources and assistance. Walk in hours are 9-12 pm on Tuesdays, or request an appointment by emailing rap@mschelps.org or calling 253.874.6718.

#### **Rental and Emergency Assistance**

Eligible individuals and families in crisis may apply for one-time stabilization support through MSC. Visit our website for more information.



#### **Supportive Housing for Single Adults**

MSC offers transitional housing for single adults identifying as male and veteran in Burien, and supportive housing for single adults identifying as female and in active recovery from substance use in Kent. Support for our tenants includes on-site case management, housing stability support, and increasing their capacity for autonomy and an eventual successful transition into longer term housing. #### William J. Wood Veterans House

Housing for homeless or imminently homeless veterans and their families with onsite services. All residents must be referred through the VA. Veterans, if you are homeless call 877-904-8387.
