

Drivers and Helpers Team

The MSC Food Bank is currently accepting applications for volunteers to join our Drivers & Helpers team.

As a member of our Drivers & Helpers team volunteers drive/assist a driver to local grocery store businesses in the Federal Way area picking up food and nonfood donated items to be distributed at our Redondo Market.

Members of the Drivers & Helpers team need to meet the following requirements to be eligible to apply:

- At least a 6-month commitment to the MSC Food Bank
- Able to lift 50+ pounds
- Pass a Washington State background check
- Pass a WSDOL drivers check
- Able to offer 10-20 hours a week of volunteer time
- Familiar with Federal Way area
- Comfortable driving and learning to drive a Ford Transit Van
- Compliant in keeping accurate and timely paperwork in reference to donated poundage
- Willing to work in the elements loading and unloading items into and out of the vans during all seasons
- Participate in a mandatory orientation/training with Food Bank staff for safety and agency specification review

Wednesdays weekly: 7:45 am – 10:45 am (Route #1) in need of a Driver and a Helper

Wednesdays weekly: 10:00 am – 12:00 pm in need of a Helper to assist our current volunteer Driver on this route

Thursdays weekly: 7:45 am – 10:45 am in need a Helper to assist current Driver

Fridays weekly: 9:00 am – 1:00 pm to assist with our Food Bridge program. This route is specific to creating pallets, loading a box truck with food stocked pallets to drop off at 4 local retirement facilities for their weekly in house Market, then picking up the pallets and filled out paperwork from each location and returning to the MSC Warehouse.
